Why SR-527 Traffic Can Contribute to Whiplash Injuries

Whiplash is commonly associated with the rapid back-and-forth movement of the head and neck during a collision. Rear-end accidents are a frequent cause because the sudden impact can place stress on the muscles, joints, ligaments, and other structures of the cervical spine.



Traffic conditions along Bothell-Everett Highway and other busy Mill Creek commuter routes can include:

- Short following distances
- Sudden braking during congestion
- Frequent merging and lane changes
- Distracted driving
- Heavy commuter traffic

Even a collision that does not appear severe can place significant stress on the neck and upper back. Symptoms may not always be obvious immediately after the accident, particularly when adrenaline and the body's natural stress response are still elevated.

Common Symptoms After a Rear-End Collision

Whiplash symptoms can involve more than neck pain. After a car accident, some people may [Chiropractor](#) experience:

- Neck stiffness or reduced range of motion
- Headaches, including pain near the base of the skull
- Shoulder tightness or soreness
- Upper or mid-back discomfort
- Muscle tension or spasms
- Jaw discomfort
- Fatigue or difficulty concentrating
- Tingling, numbness, or discomfort extending into an arm

Symptoms can vary considerably from one person to another. If discomfort develops, persists, or becomes more noticeable after a collision, an appropriate healthcare evaluation can help determine what may be contributing to the symptoms.



Why Evaluation After a Car Accident Matters
