Broken Springs, Cables, Rollers, and Tracks

Both systems store substantial energy and should not be handled carelessly.

Signs of spring trouble include a door that feels abnormally heavy, a visible gap in the spring, a loud snapping sound, or a door that rises only a few inches. A garage door safety inspection should check the reversal function, cables, springs, brackets, rollers, tracks, hinges, weather seal, and opener force settings. If the door shuts violently, reverses unexpectedly, or fails to reverse when an obstruction is detected, discontinue use until a professional assesses the system.

Garage door repair pricing may include a diagnostic charge or **service call fee**, labor, parts, disposal, after-hours charges, and applicable taxes. Some companies credit the service call fee toward approved repairs, while others do not. Ask before scheduling.

Garage Door Panel Repair or Replacement
