Important Documents and Valuables

Prescription medications and any medical equipment needed daily should also stay with you, since access to the truck is not always immediate once it arrives at the new address.

Laptops, external hard drives, and small electronics containing important data are worth transporting personally, both for security and to avoid any risk of damage during transport. Movers in DMV also suggest keeping small sentimental items, like photo albums or heirloom jewelry, in your own vehicle rather than packed among other belongings.
