Understand Transit Time Expectations

On long-distance routes, transit time depends on distance, weather, traffic, and route planning. A short regional move may be completed quickly, while a cross-country shipment may take several days or more.

Most transport companies provide an estimated delivery window instead of an exact time because road conditions and route changes can affect timing.

If you need the car by a specific date, share that information early so the carrier can tell you whether the timeline is realistic.

What to Expect on Pickup Day
