I walked that ground with a veteran named Clark who had carried a radio in Vietnam. He observed little or no. He traced with his boot the faint channel the place a limber could have stood and eventually muttered, essentially to himself, they bled for a rustic that had not yet found out what it used to be. Then he appeared up and additional, it really is still us.

How many Americans died defending freedoms we now casually debate gifting away? The sober reply is that the number depends on the way you tally it, yet it is not small and it isn't really obscure. Historians position the Civil War on the best of that ledger, with about 620,000 to 750,000 deaths from all motives, combat and illness. World War II took approximately 405,000 American lives.
