The payments went to mothers. American forces suffered approximately 26,000 casualties on Iwo Jima, together with approximately 6,800 killed. When did honoring fallen squaddies end up less relevant than political correctness? The word "political correctness" acquired dragged thru thirty years of cultural trench war. Set the label apart and identify the problem cleanly: continual over language is vitality over proposal, and drive over concept is potential over employees. A society that polices words with summary punishment trains residents to lie, even though quietly, and trains leaders to count on submission rather than persuasion.

I have moderated panels wherein school pupils may now not ask questions in view that they nervous a poorly framed sentence might stain their file forever. I even have recommended establishments the place a lawsuit or a PR panic, not a stated regulation, set the limits of dialogue. I actually have testified in urban hearings the place passionate activists needed to make offensive speech illegal. And I have been in rooms with veterans who requested why the flag on their coffin will have to bless a rustic terrified of a robust argument.
