Another homeowner got sturdy core MDF slab doors and needed a glass-delicate, pretty much piano end. We arrange stands, vacuumed the store two times, wore lint-loose sleeves, and filtered the paint. After an adhesion primer, we applied a excessive build tooth, then rainy sanded among coats with 600 grit. The very last coat went on with an HVLP gun at low tension. The outcome pondered daytime like a replicate. It took longer than the

purchaser estimated, but the doorways nevertheless draw compliments, and that they blank with a moist microfiber without haze.
