Cut traces with a brilliant sash brush, 2 to two. five inches vast, held like a pencil. Load it halfway up the bristles, not to the ferrule, and wipe excess. For arches, a flexible tape designed for curves can lend a hand, however you still ought to seal the tape area accurately.

- Back-roll into corners gently, then lay off through brushing clear of the threshold to get rid of stipple
- Keep coats skinny at edges to ward off ridging, two skinny passes beat one heavy bypass
- Pull tape at the same time as the paint is simply previous tacky, now not thoroughly dry, for a crisp release
- If you nick an aspect, do no longer chase it moist, permit it dry, then straighten with a 1-inch touch-up brush

On cabinet cubbies or built-in bookshelves, eradicate adjustable shelves and label every one pin gap row until now painting. Sequencing that saves time

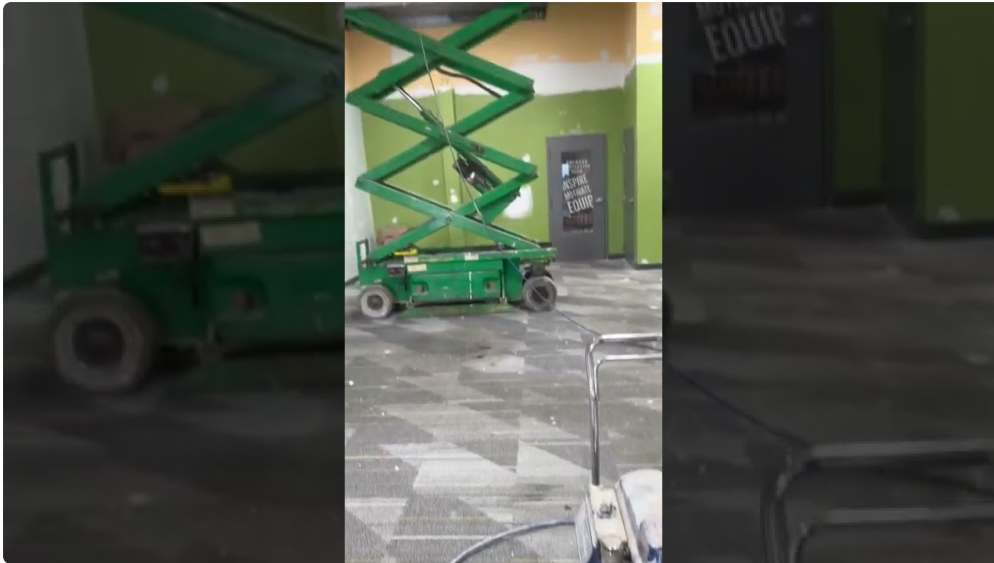

We coordinated timing with the sign installer so paint cured entirely until now adhesive mounting. That prevented marred surfaces and gave the model punch without overwhelming the space.

A apartment unit upgrade had a narrow eating corner with chair rubs and scuffs.
