Understanding the Betting Options

- The left reel chooses a bet spot (a number or a bonus video game).
- The right reel picks a random multiplier (varying from 2x approximately 50x).

If the Top Slot successfully matches the winning segment on the main wheel, the multiplier is applied either to the winning number payment or to the multipliers inside the subsequent bonus video game. This mechanic is important for those aiming to maximize their potential returns when they wager Crazy Time.

Common Approaches to Betting

- **The Bonus Hunter Approach:**
 - Ignores the numbers totally.
 - Places simultaneous bets on all 4 reward rounds (*Coin Flip*, *Pachinko*, *Cash Hunt*, and *Crazy Time*).
 - High volatility; relies entirely on striking perk rounds often enough to offset the continuous losses on non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**

- Combines a foundational bet on a frequent number (like 2 or 5) with calculated protection of high-probability perk video games.
- Objectives to strike a balance in between routine little wins and the enjoyment of going after significant bonus offer sets off.
