1. **Float Value**-- The lower the float (0.0-- 1.0), the cleaner the surface. Very little wear (Factory New or Minimal Wear) frequently commands a premium.
2. **Pattern/StatTrak™**-- StatTrak™ skins (those that track eliminates) are generally scarcer than their vanilla counterparts.
3. **Case or Collection Age**-- Skins from discontinued cases (e.g., *The Arms Deal* Case) end up being progressively scarce as the case stops dropping.
