

Which Are the Most Frequent Garage Door Problems?

An overhead garage door is one of the largest moving systems in a Los Angeles home. It includes springs, cables, rollers, tracks, hinges, panels, weather seals, and an automatic opener. A failure in any one of these garage door parts can leave the door unsafe, noisy, or unable to operate.

Los Angeles has a generally temperate, dry climate, but seasonal heat and strong sun exposure can age weather seals, plastic components, and painted garage door surfaces. If the opener hums but the door does not move, the drive system, trolley, spring, or connection arm may need inspection by a professional.

If the garage door won't close, inspect the photo-eye sensors near the bottom of each side of the opening. These sensors must face each other and remain free of dust, cobwebs, and obstructions. Misalignment can cause the opener to reverse or refuse to close the door. Do not bypass the sensors, because they are an essential safety feature for preventing entrapment.

A remote control may also be the problem. Try the wall-mounted control, replace the remote battery, and confirm that the remote is programmed correctly. If the wall control works but the remote does not, the issue may be isolated to the remote control or receiver.

Track alignment is another possibility. A bent vertical track, improperly secured bracket, or interference can cause sticking.
