The “penguin contract”: get agreement early

Before you do whatever problematical, you're negotiating.

You're asking the viewers to simply accept a foolish premise: definite, penguins can do magic, certain, we're going to pretend for just a little, and no, nobody's getting embarrassed if they wager unsuitable. That sounds fluffy, yet it's practical. The moment you put that tone, you cut the power on the target market. They think reliable to react loudly.

My preferred approach to do this is to speak like the penguin is a person with suggestions.

Not “right here's a magic trick.” More like, “Meet my penguin chum. He most effective works whilst the audience plays along. If you whisper, he receives shy. If you clap, he gets convinced.”

That line does three issues rapid:

1. It provides humans a activity (clap or whisper, depending on your fashion).
2. It units up an envisioned rhythm, so later which you could accelerate or slow down devoid of dropping them.
3. It frames the relaxation of the regimen as a collaboration, no longer you acting at them.

Penguin Magic works only when the target market feels just like the “penguin buddy” desires them, not the alternative method round.

Build your first hook around a plain, noticeable win

For target audience hooks, complexity isn't the aspect. Readability is.

Phase 4: calm down and landing

You end with something fulfilling but now not laborious. It deserve to experience comprehensive and wrap the penguin tale.
