4. Utilize "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the most affordable overall worth wins) flips basic reasoning on its head. While it can be enjoyable, it relies completely on striking inexpensive, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with basic case-opening reasoning.
