

How Often Should Sprinkler Systems Be Serviced in Northern Utah A sprinkler system that runs fine in May does not necessarily mean it is running efficiently by August, which is why regular service matters more in Northern Utah than a lot of homeowners realize. Heads shift, lines develop small leaks, and controllers fall out of sync with actual watering restrictions over a single season, all of which quietly waste water and leave dry patches that only show up once the damage is visible. 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A seasonal check before the heat of summer and again before winterizing catches most problems before they turn into a dead section of lawn. Rocky Weber County soil also puts extra stress on buried lines compared to sandier ground, which is one more reason a yearly check pays off.
