Keep photo-eye sensors clean, aligned, and free from boxes, tools, or landscaping materials. The sensors should face each other across the opening. Avoid adjusting springs, cables, or brackets without professional guidance.

Learn how to use the manual release cord in an emergency, but pull it only when the door is fully closed whenever possible. Releasing a door while it is open can allow it to fall if the springs or cables are damaged. During routine maintenance, lubricate approved moving parts, inspect weatherstripping, and watch for deterioration caused by heat and occasional rain.
