

A windshield chip looks small until it does not. One hard snap from a truck tire, one bright starburst near the edge of the glass, one cold morning after a warm afternoon, and that tiny mark can become the reason your vehicle needs a full front windshield replacement instead of a quick rock chip repair.

That is the blunt truth most drivers learn too late. Windshield chip repair is not a cosmetic favor to your car. It is a safety call. The windshield is part of the vehicle's safety system, tied to visibility, occupant protection, and, on many newer vehicles, driver-assist cameras mounted behind the glass.
