What to stage, and what not to

Stage heavy and cumbersome first: systems, kiosks, fencing, and broken leases. Flatten cardboard and bundle it with tape so it stacks tight and quick. Keep electronics and batteries out of the final pile. Label bags that comprise broken glass or sharp particles so crews can glove up and cargo them ultimate. Do now not soak bags with drinks to "avert filth" - that only creates mess and weight bills. If florals are going to compost, shake out water first and consolidate into blank packing containers.
