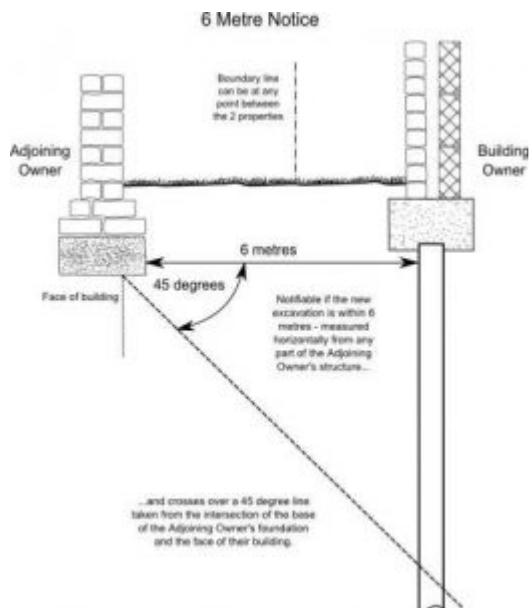
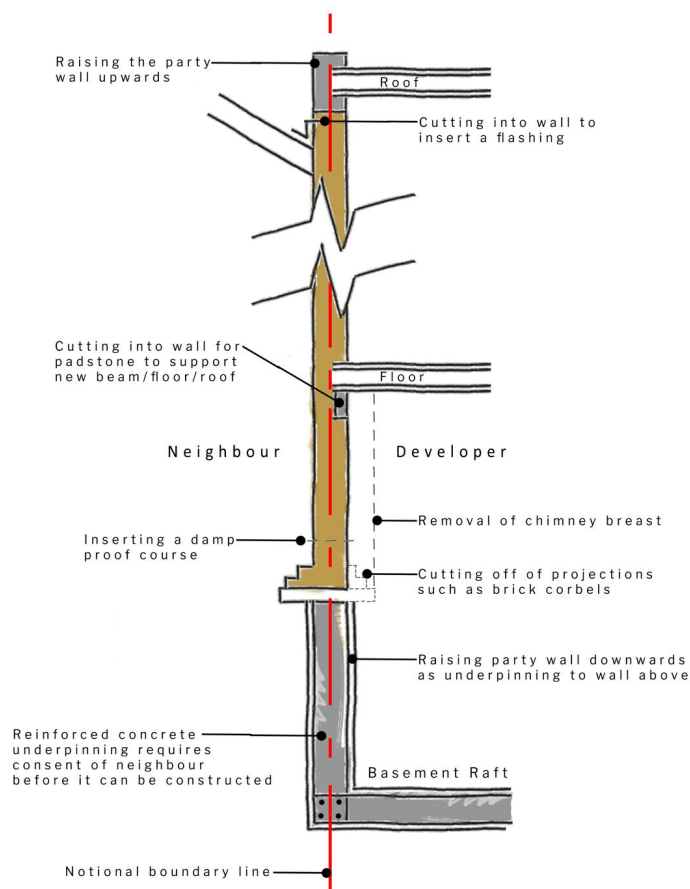




Party wall section showing typical notifiable works
