

Garage Door Repair Work in Los Angeles

Garage Door Opener Installation Cost

Garage door opener installation cost varies according to motor strength, drive type, ceiling height, wiring, mounting requirements, and whether the old opener must be removed. A **chain-drive opener** is often reliable and economical, although it can produce more vibration and noise.
