2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

If the standard Martingale is too stressful, the Reverse Martingale concentrates on profiting from winning streaks while keeping losses very little.

- **How it works:** You double your bet after every **win**, and reset to your base bet after every **loss**.
- **Goal:** Ride a hot streak of 3 to 4 wins in a row, then cash out and reset. This protects your core balance while letting the house's cash trip throughout a streak.

3. The Low Multiplier Auto-Cashout Strategy (Conservative)

This strategy prioritizes consistency and longevity over enormous, life-altering payments.

- **How it works:** You set an **Auto-Cashout** at a very conservative multiplier, normally between **1.15 x and 1.30 x**.
