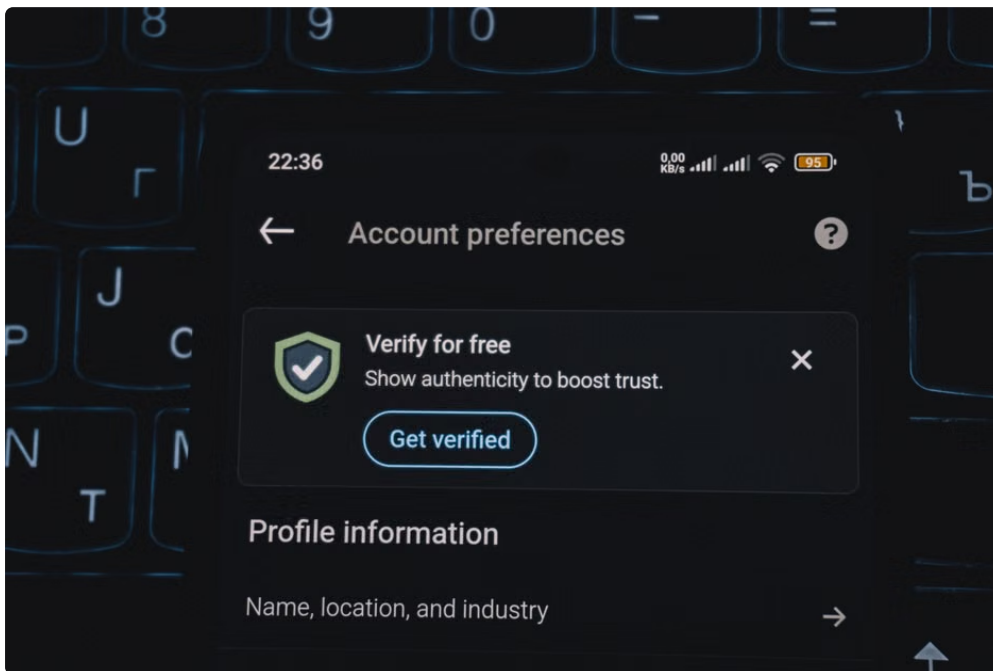
Installing BingoPlus on iPhone and iPad
