Third. Offer a Practical Reason

If you believe the need to justify your determination, offer a practical reason — such as "We have limited space." Kollysphere's experts recommend keeping explanations short and matter-of-fact.

Fourth. Handle It One-on-One

Should you know that particular guests might be touchy about the adults-only guideline, look into addressing them individually prior to distributing the invitation.

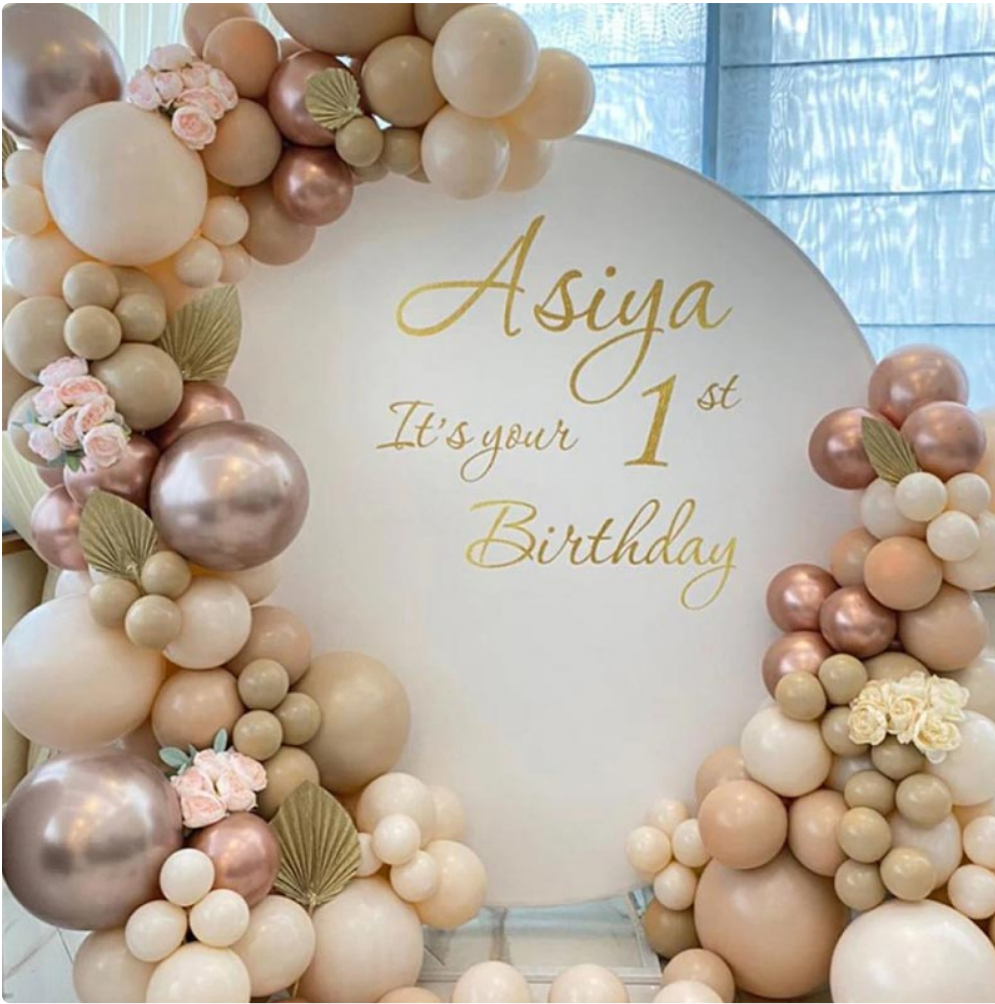
5. Apply the Rule to Everyone
