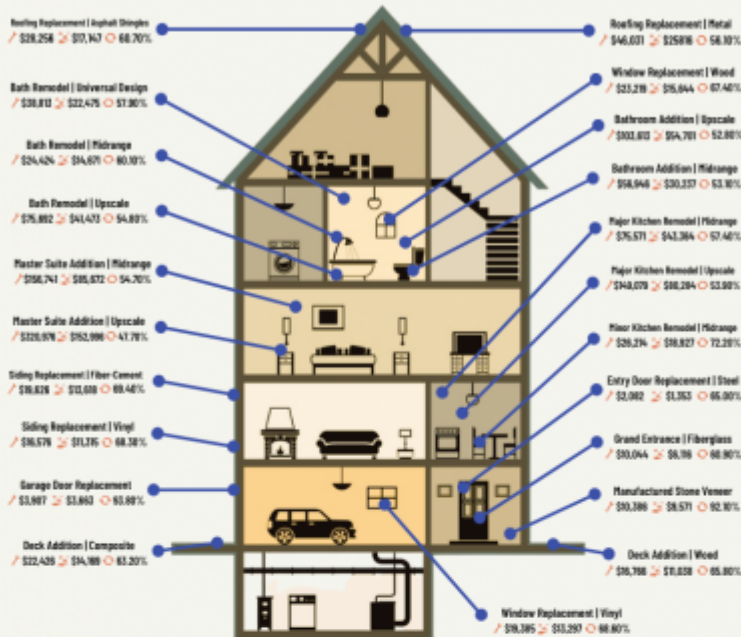


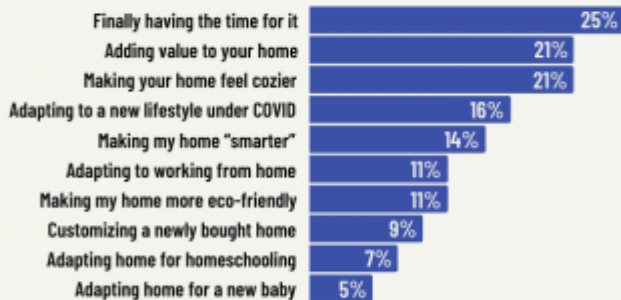

LEGEND: / JOB COST > RESALE VALUE < COST RECOVERED



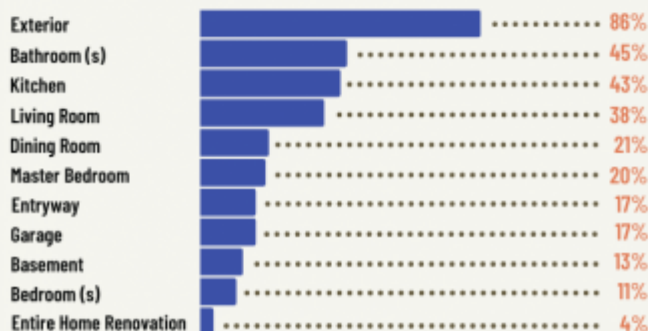
