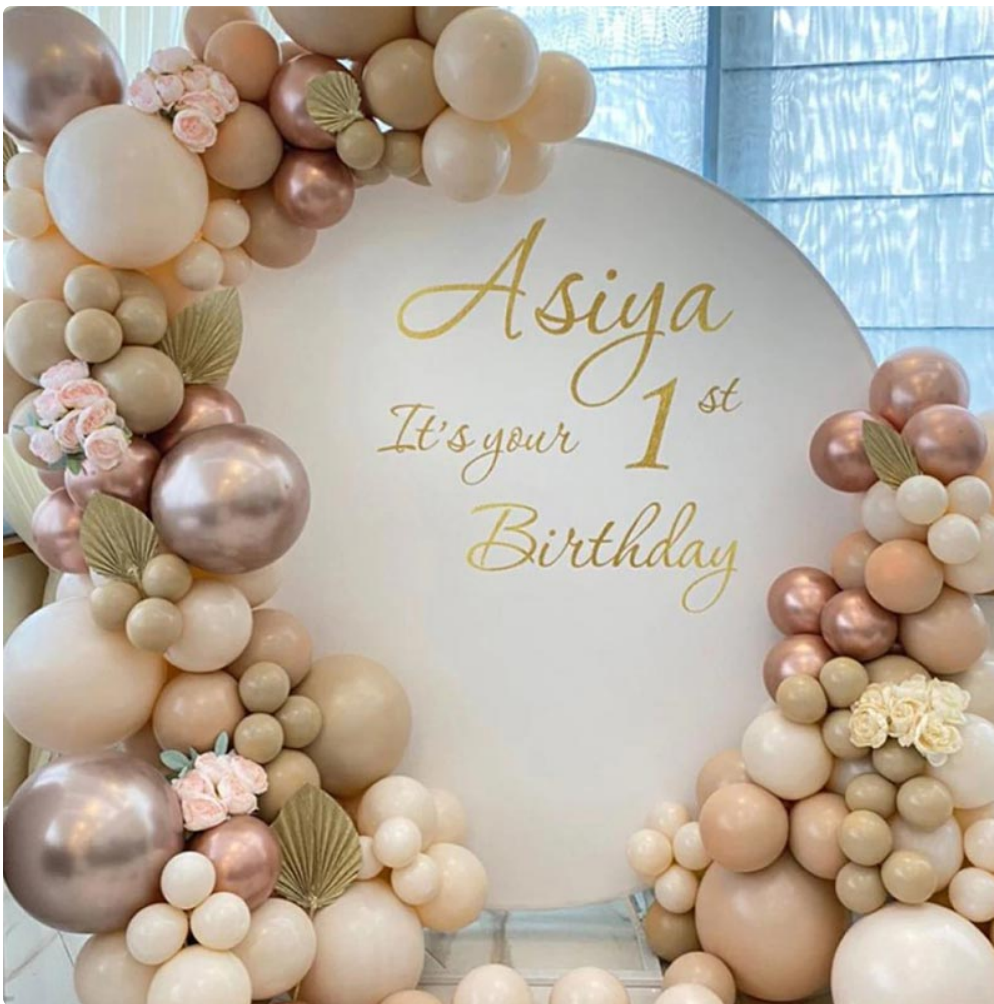
Our experts advise employing a measuring device for exactness, and always verify entry points and hallways to guarantee that your equipment, furniture, and decor will go through unencumbered by issues.

First. Theatre Configuration

Tiers of seats oriented toward a performance area. This is excellent for presentations but unsuitable for dining or socialising.



2. Round Table Layout

Round tables with chairs positioned around them. This is excellent for meals and fosters interaction.

Third. Standing Layout

High tables distributed throughout the space, with no fixed chairs. This is ideal for mingling and fosters flow.

Fourth. Half-Round Layout

Crescent-shaped tables with seating arranged on the outside edge, oriented toward the stage. This blends the finest of theatre and banquet configurations.

5. Boardroom Configuration

Tables arranged in a U or hollow rectangular shape, with seating on the exterior edge. This layout is perfect for presentations and promotes collaboration.

3. Design the Seating Plan

Once you have picked your layout option, it is time to design your seating plan. Begin by designating tables to your guests. Take into account dynamics, personalities, and any issues that might affect the seating arrangement.
