

Highway 14 climbs out of the San Fernando Valley and into open desert within about an hour's drive, carrying commuters, families and clients north toward Lancaster and the rest of the Antelope Valley. Alpha Recovery Center sits just off this route, making the trip from most parts of Los Angeles a straightforward drive rather than a complicated one. The drive itself marks a real shift in scenery, leaving the density of the city behind for the open high desert around Lancaster. Clients and family members coming from central or west Los Angeles typically take Interstate 5 north before merging onto the Antelope Valley Freeway, known locally as Highway 14, and following it through Santa Clarita and up into Palmdale and Lancaster. Those without a car can also reach the area by the Metrolink Antelope Valley Line, which runs regular service between Union Station in downtown Los Angeles and stops in Lancaster, making the trip possible without a personal vehicle at all. Families coming from the San Fernando Valley [drug rehabs Los Angeles](#) or Santa Clarita generally find the drive up Highway 14 takes well under two hours even with normal traffic, and clients coming from further out in Los Angeles County can add that time when planning an arrival. Once off the freeway, the facility is easy to find at 7316 W Ave D-8, with a wheelchair accessible entrance and a wheelchair accessible parking lot for clients or visiting family members who need it. Language assistance is available on site as well for families more comfortable communicating in a language other than English, and staff can walk callers through directions in advance so the drive itself is one less thing to worry about. The residential facility sits on landscaped grounds with a gym and a swimming pool, giving arriving clients a calmer first impression than a clinical building might.

Because admissions calls are answered 24 hours a day, seven days a week, a family driving up Highway 14 can call ahead at any hour to confirm arrival details or ask questions along the way. The facility holds a 5.0 star rating from 43 Google reviews, and staff such as Liz and Chris are frequently mentioned by former clients as easy to reach and quick to help once someone arrives. The on site therapist, Bryan, and the chef, Ted, are two more names that come up often once families settle in after the drive.
