When the ceiling is honestly wild, I use a stepped mind-set. The cabinet carcass stops 1 to 2 inches shy, then a paint-grade fascia bridges the remaining bit, scribed and caulked. The joint becomes an intentional show, now not an accident. On stain-grade custom woodwork, you can't caulk, so your tolerance needs to be tighter and your scribe thicker. Carcasses do the heavy lifting; face frames and doors are the smile. In tall runs, I go with materials and joinery that continue to be appropriate over height. For paint-grade, three/4 inch plywood with hardwood face frames resists racking. On a nine or 10 foot unit, I double up the back panel or upload vertical back stiffeners, incredibly if cabinets will lift one hundred plus pounds of books or cookware.

If you are jogging open built-in shelving to the ceiling, you need to give some thought to sag. Anchoring is non-negotiable. Tall circumstances are tipped closer to you by means of physics by myself. I screw into studs using a ledger or a French cleat hidden behind the ideal rail. In seismic zones, I upload L brackets top and low, thru the thicker constituents of the cabinet, and I upsize fasteners to three inch structural screws with washers. Paint-grade or stain-grade, and how finish transformations the build

Doors deserve a minute. Full peak slab doorways seem innovative, however on very tall runs, they get heavy and will rack unless you spec taller or extra hinges. I movement to a 5 or six hinge pattern on 8 to nine foot doors and pick better grade hardware. In many instances, splitting the elevation right into a cut door set and upper glass doors breaks the mass and supports with access. In kitchens, glass uppers make sense for monitor. Depth influences comfort. Library cabinets at 11 inches save paperbacks neat. Cookbooks prefer 12 to thirteen inches. On topmost doorways, cross bigger or settle on pulls which you could hook with a finger from a step stool. I circumvent push latches on ceiling-top doors.
