- **The Martingale System:** A traditional betting technique where a player doubles their bet after every loss, aiming to recover all previous losses plus a revenue when they lastly win. This requires a huge bankroll and typically hits platform betting limits.
- **The High-Risk Sniper:** Waiting for a long streak of low crashes (e.g., a number of rounds ending under 1.5 x) under the incorrect presumption that a "high multiplier is due."

The Illusion of Control and the Gambler's Fallacy
