Common Garage Door Problems in Torrance Homes

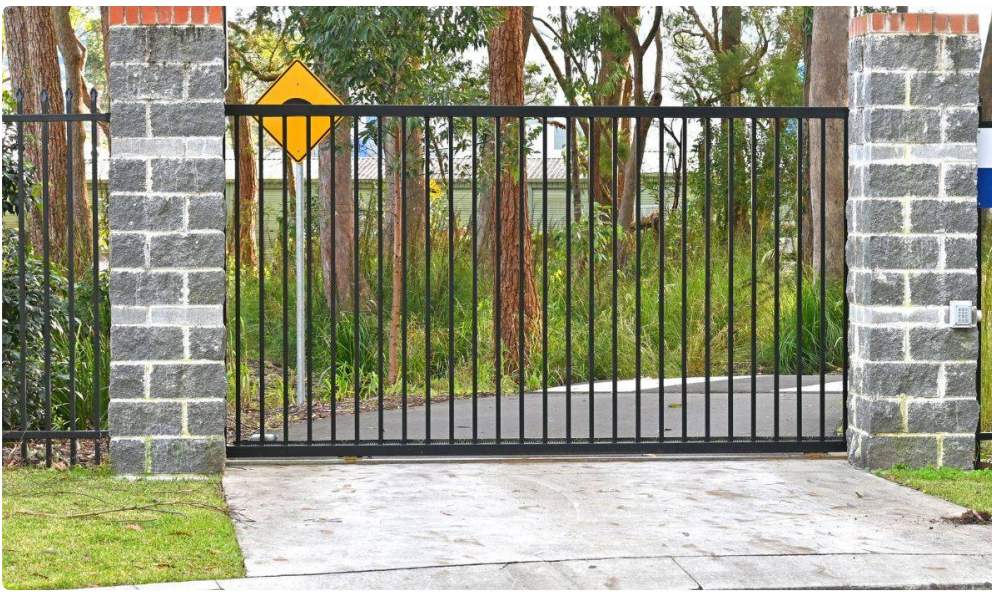

Failed Springs, Cables, Rollers, and Hinges

Safety sensors near the floor must be aligned with each other and remain unobstructed. If the indicator lights are off or blinking, the opener may fail to close the door. Do not disable the safety sensors; they are designed to reverse the door if a person, pet, or object is in the opening.
