Oddly since it is a charming city, has a great marina, beaches and the Santa Barbara Castle (Castillo) many people promptly leave the flight terminal either southern in the direction of Torrevieja or north in the direction of Benidorm. First there is El Montiboli, El Campello, (the renowned caves of Canelobre are just inland near Busot) then San Juan and afterwards we struck Alicante, the entrance to the Costa Blanca. South of Villajoyosa there is a succession of similar coastline resorts with high rise house blocks and hotels although nothing like as big as Benidorm. Much more inland is the big community of Alcoy, (additionally referred to as Alcoi) well-known for its lots of bridges, Muro de Alcoy, Bocarent, Castalla, Ibi, Cocentaina, Albaida, Xixona and Ontinyent.

- Villajoyosa's background dates back over 3,000 years, with significant historical sites from the Roman duration, consisting of a well-preserved Roman bathhouse.
- Alongside the Marina Rubicon shopping mall, you'll locate a vibrant miniature golf course, suitable for children. Some hotels additionally have their own mini golf training courses.
- Morning or late afternoon use the best light and cooler temperature levels.
- Campello Coastline is a wonderful area for water sporting activities enthusiasts.
- Watercrafts run frequently from the port and the trip takes around 1 hour.

Villamartin Visitor Details-- A little inland but near beaches and in particular close to several popular fairway. San Pedro del Pinatar Visitor Info-- Has a long beachfront and marina in the Lo Pagan area. Pueblo Lucero Visitor Information-- Urbanisation near Rojales and the La Marquesa Fairway. Pinoso Visitor Information-- Pinoso is a traditional Spanish community that is famous for its regional manufacturing of fine white wines, marble and rock salt.
