What is Crazy Time?

The centerpiece of the game is a massive, vertically mounted wheel containing 54 sections. Players position bets on where they think the wheel will stop after a spin. Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time efficiently, players should first comprehend the wagering layout. The 54 sections on the wheel are divided into number bets and bonus game bets. Each segment uses various payment capacities and likelihoods.

Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payment: 5:1
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1

Benefit Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.

- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before every spin of the main wheel, a tiny two-reel fruit machine situated above the main wheel spins at the same time.

- **How it Works:** The left reel shows among the wagering choices (numbers or bonus video games), while the right reel shows a multiplier (ranging from 2x up to 50x).
- **The Result:** If the sign on the left reel matches the result of the main wheel spin, the multiplier is used to that win. If it indicates a benefit game, the multiplier uses to all multipliers inside that specific bonus round.

Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The true magic of the video game occurs when the wheel arrive at one of the four bonus offer sectors. Players who have positioned a bet on that particular benefit round are transferred to a secondary video game screen, where enormous multipliers wait for.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the 4 bonus rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a machine. Before the flip, random multipliers are assigned to both sides of the coin. Whichever side lands face up determines the gamer's payment.

- **Benefit function:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some cases be activated, offering gamers another possibility at higher benefits.

2. Cash Hunt

Gamers exist with a massive interactive screen displaying a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers hidden behind different symbols (like a cactus, target, or constable's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to aim and shoot at one symbol before a countdown timer expires. As soon as the timer ends, all signs expose their hidden multipliers, and the gamer is awarded the multiplier they strike.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the traditional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko includes a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck cascades downward, it bounces randomly off the pegs before landing in among several multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck arrive on a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

The ultimate perk round. Gamers walk through a red door into a surreal, virtual world including a massive, 64-segment mega wheel.

- **The Gameplay:** The player (or the host, depending on the video game variation) selects among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel also includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" sectors, permitting fortunate gamers to set off astronomical wins up to the video game's cap of 20,000 x.

Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is essentially a game of possibility dictated by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, players frequently use various techniques to manage their bankroll and optimize home entertainment.

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
 - Focus primarily on betting numbers 1 and 2, that make up a big part of the wheel. This method yields frequent, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll steady and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread little bets throughout all four perk rounds while sometimes backing number 10. This ensures eligibility for the high-paying reward video games without draining funds too quickly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets exclusively on the benefit rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This style needs persistence and a larger bankroll, as droughts can occur, however it uses direct access to the game's highest prospective payments.

Best Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed quantity to invest before beginning the game and never chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that bonus offer bets generally have a somewhat lower RTP than simple number bets, suggesting they are higher threat, greater reward.
3. **Delight in the Show:** Treat the betting expense as the cost of admission to an interactive game program. The main goal ought to always be entertainment.
