Benefits and drawbacks

Pros

- Fast gameplay: each round lasts seconds, providing instantaneous satisfaction.
- Easy guidelines: no need for map knowledge or goal training.
- Potential for high returns (e.g., a 10 × cash-out can increase a modest stake considerably).
- Lots of platforms provide provably reasonable algorithms, permitting gamers to verify round integrity.

Cons

- **High house edge:** most websites maintain ~ 2-- 5% of total wagers, making long-term revenue challenging.
