Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the primary wheel, a smaller sized two-reel slot device situated straight above the wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins at the same time.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot generates one random wheel segment (a number or a reward game) and pairs it with a random multiplier ranging from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the main wheel lands on the specific segment revealed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is used to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payment is multiplied. If it is a perk video game, the multipliers within the

bonus offer round are improved accordingly.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 sector on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a vibrant, surreal virtual world including an enormous 64-segment wheel. The host selects among three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, permitting multipliers to reach up to an incredible 20,000 x.

- **Prioritize the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, your house edge on the number segments (1, 2, 5, 10) is normally greater than the bonus offer rounds. Numerous experienced players choose to place little bets solely on the four bonus sectors to chase the video game's optimum payment capacity.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The hectic nature of live game programs can lead to quick spending. Choose a set bankroll before you start playing and stay with it, despite wins or losses.
