

Skin Tags: What Are They & Can They Be Removed?

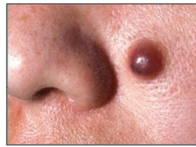
TYPES OF SKIN LESION CHEAT SHEET



Bulla
Circumscribed collection of free fluid > 1 cm



Macule
Circular flat discoloration < 1cm brown, blue, red or hypopigmented



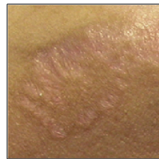
Nodule
Circular, Elevated, Solid Lesion > 1 cm



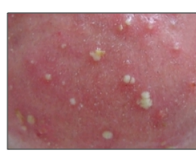
Patch
Circumscribed Flat Discoloration > 1cm



Papule
Superficial solid elevated, ≤ 0.5 cm, color varies



Plaque
Superficial elevated solid flat topped lesion > 1 cm



Pustule
Vesicle containing puss (inflammatory cells)



Vesicle
Circular collection of free fluid ≤ 1 cm



Wheal
Edematous, transitory, plaque, may last few hours



Scale
Epidermal thickening; consists of flakes of plates of compacted desquamated layers of stratum corneum



Crust
Dried serum or Exudate on skin



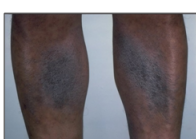
Fissure
Crack or split



Excoriation
Linear erosion



Erosion
Loss of epidermis superficial; part or all of the epidermis has been lost



Lichenification
Thickening of the epidermis seen with exaggeration of Normal skin lines



Scar
Thickening; permanent fibrotic changes that occur on the skin following damage of the epidermis

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Look And Reasons For Skin Tags

Skin tags are little, measuring 1 to 5 mm, and hardly ever expand to 1 to 2 centimeters. Acrochordons are neither uncomfortable nor tender however can be troublesome. People usually report that skin tags catch on garments or precious jewelry, such as pendants. Periodically, the consistent rubbing in between the garments and the skin tag can cause blood loss or itching. Skin tags are little, soft, benign growths that frequently create where skin massages against skin or apparel.

Trying elimination at home can lead to infection or scarring. Skin tags show up in a range of sizes and shapes, from a few millimeters to a few centimeters. Their appearance can be affected by factors such as genes, excessive weight, and hormone modifications (such as those experienced during pregnancy or due to problems like insulin resistance).
