both of the vials

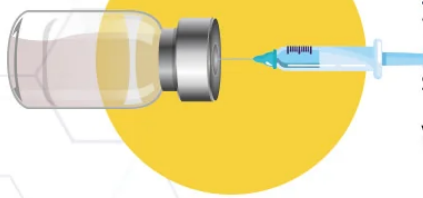


4. Open Vial Tops

Add .5ml to 2ml of
water (see chart below)

5. Insert Needle



With peptide vial
sideways – GENTLY inject
water into peptide



6. Dissolve peptide

Slowly roll the peptide
or let sit for 20 min



7. Storage

Use or refrigerate
peptide
