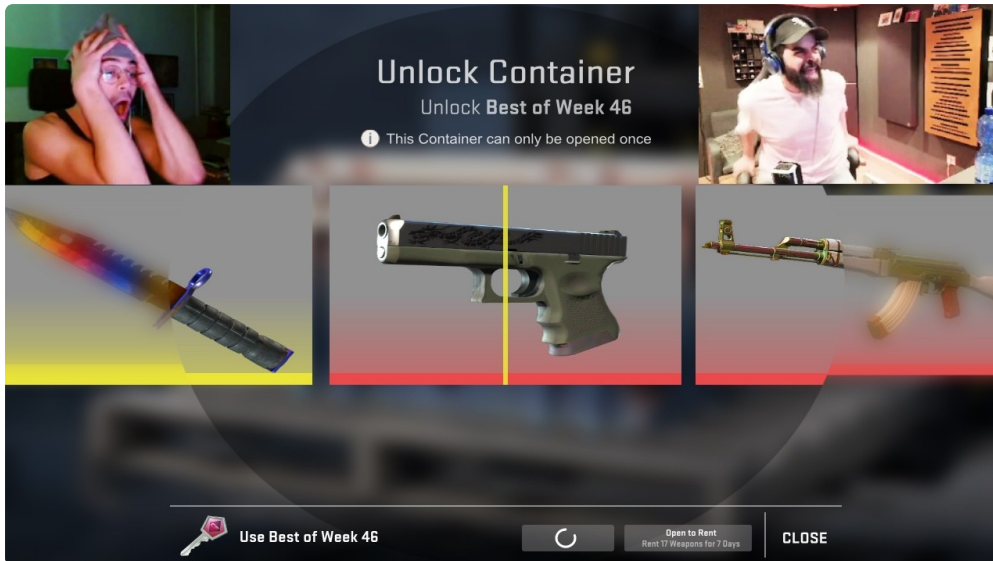

These cases are frequently dismissed because of their low rate tags, but they still include a handful of preferable skins that periodically command a premium.

Pros and Cons of Going Cheap

Advantages

- **Low financial danger**-- Even a streak of "misfortune" won't greatly affect the bankroll.
- **High volume of openings**-- Players can open numerous more cases for the exact same amount invested in a premium case.
- **Knowing chance**-- Newcomers can practice unboxing mechanics without feeling pressured by high stakes.

Drawbacks

- **Lower general value**-- The average return is generally a fraction of the case rate.
