What on-site locksmith work changes in Orlando

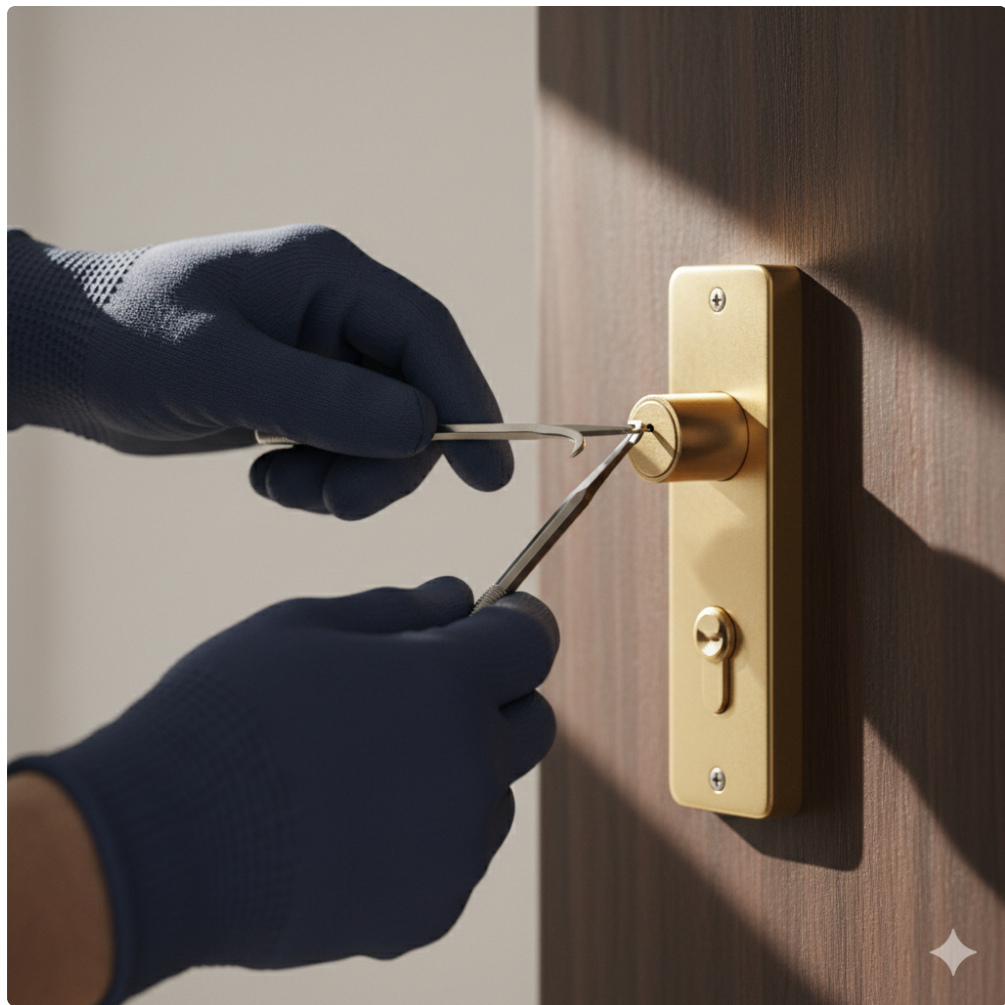
