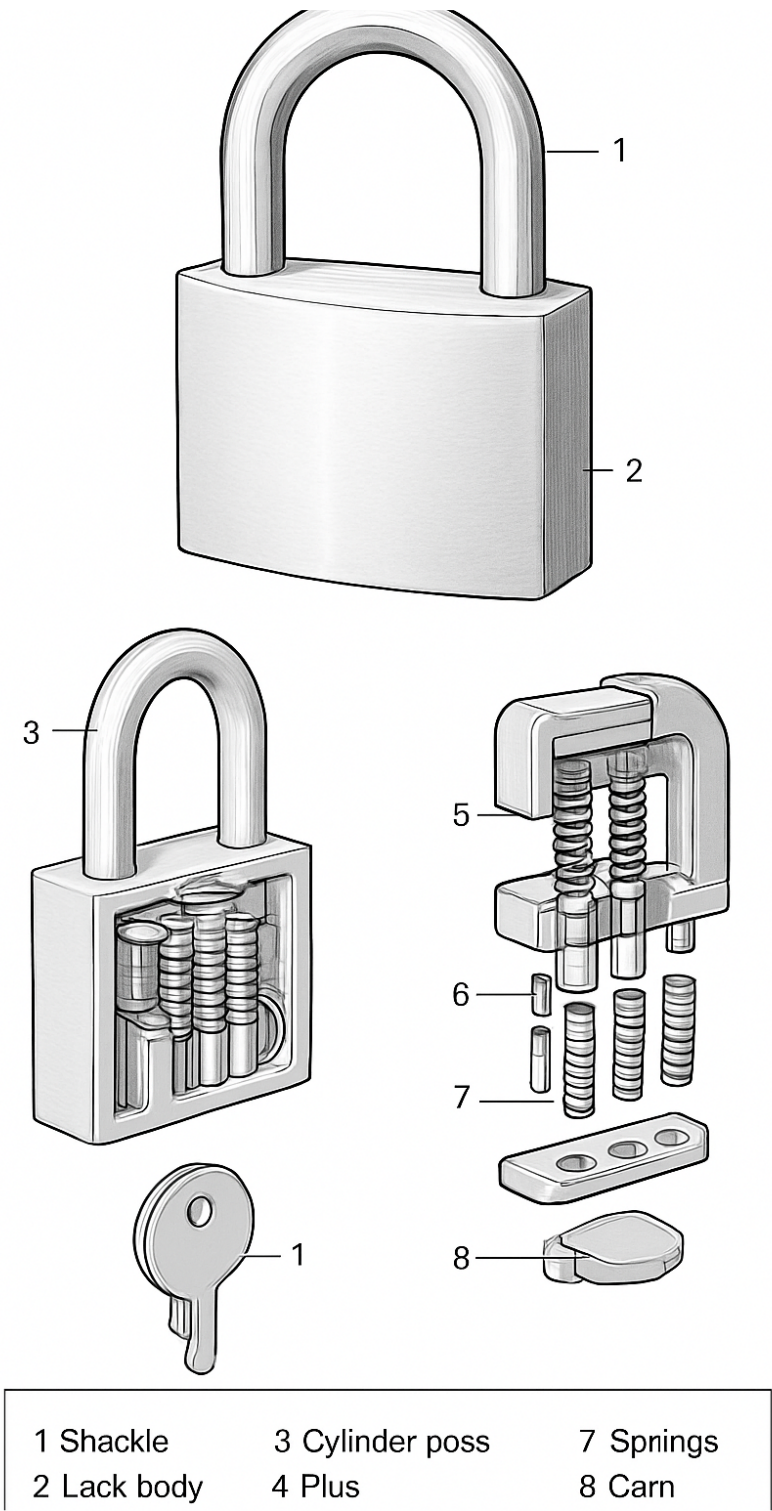
How to think about service quality
