Benefits and drawbacks

Pros



- Fast gameplay: each round lasts seconds, delivering pleasure principle.
- Simple rules: no need for map knowledge or aim training.
- Prospective for high returns (e.g., a 10 × cash-out can multiply a modest stake dramatically).
- Many platforms provide provably reasonable algorithms, permitting gamers to confirm round integrity.

Cons

- **High home edge:** most websites maintain ~ 2-- 5% of overall wagers, making long-term revenue difficult.
