In a loft upkeep with concrete floors, the buyer wanted a stone monolith. We used a leathered black granite with subtle move, double waterfall ends, and included metal angles throughout the island for rigidity. The darkish legs grounded the space and matched with black-framed windows. The seam nearly disappeared simply because the granite's movement became tight and non-directional. The purely modification I might make in hindsight is to lift the toe by 1/eight inch more. Industrial floors are rarely ideal, and the installer needed to do greater scribing to avert a daytime line at the base.

A couple with a love for real marble insisted on a complete-top Statuario waterfall. We typical that etching may turn up, so we targeted on craft. The retailer vein-matched pinnacle to leg, and we set a refined shadow divulge, a 1/eight inch set-returned the place the vertical meets the cupboard area, to border the stone like a panel. The end result appeared intentional in preference to in simple terms mass. They seal once a year and live with the patina. When a chip appeared after a heavy pot clipped the corner, a knowledgeable fix tech crammed and polished it in an hour. The fix is invisible until you catch the mild just true.
