

A faulty garage door can impact safety, everyday comfort, and access to your home. Inspect the track visually for an obstruction or severe bend, but avoid forcing the door. A door that binds in the track may have worn rollers, damaged hinges, or a cable problem. If the opener hums, strains, or repeatedly stops, continued use can harm the motor and lifting mechanism.

Why Is the Garage Door Noisy, Crooked, or Off Track?

A noisy garage door may have dry hinges, worn garage door rollers, loose fasteners, or a failing spring. Normal operation should produce some sound, but grinding, scraping, popping, or sharp snapping noises deserve attention. Lubricating appropriate moving parts can help, but lubricant will not resolve a broken spring, bent garage door track, or damaged bearing.

A crooked door often signals unbalanced cable tension, a damaged garage door cable, a faulty roller, or a spring problem. A torsion spring positioned above the door may be broken if there is a noticeable gap in the coil or if the door suddenly feels exceptionally heavy. An extension spring system, which extends along horizontal tracks, can also fail and may have separated or fallen hardware.

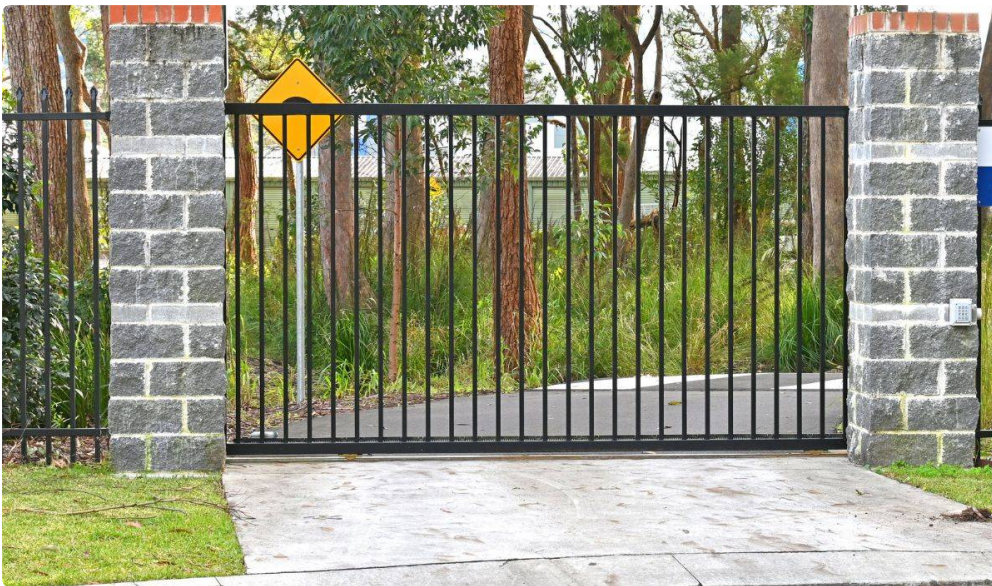
