The 50% rule is straightforward: multiply the age of your refrigerator in years by its original purchase price, or estimate what a similar new model costs today. If the repair estimate falls below half that number, repair makes financial sense. If it exceeds 50% of replacement cost, replacing the appliance is the wiser long-term investment. This rule accounts for the fact that aging refrigerators accumulate problems—once one component fails, others often follow within months or years. A thermostat repair on a three-year-old refrigerator might cost \$200 to \$400, making repair logical. The same repair on a ten-year-old unit could consume \$300 to \$600, which may represent 50% or more of a new refrigerator's cost, shifting the balance toward replacement. A thermostat replacement typically runs between \$200 and \$500 in parts and labor, depending on the refrigerator brand and model complexity.
