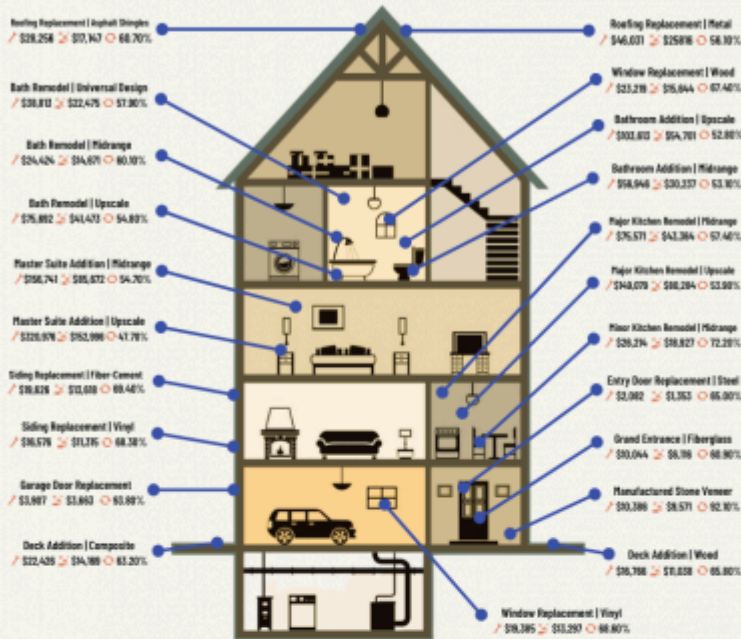

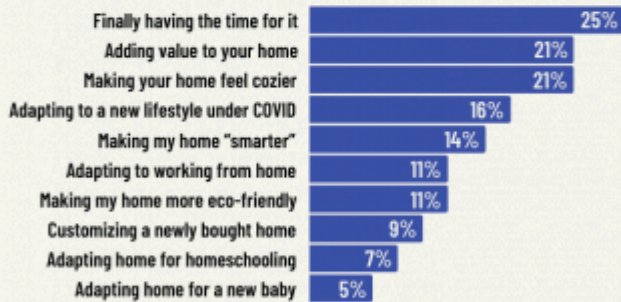

LEGEND: / JOB COST > RESALE VALUE ○ COST RECOVERED



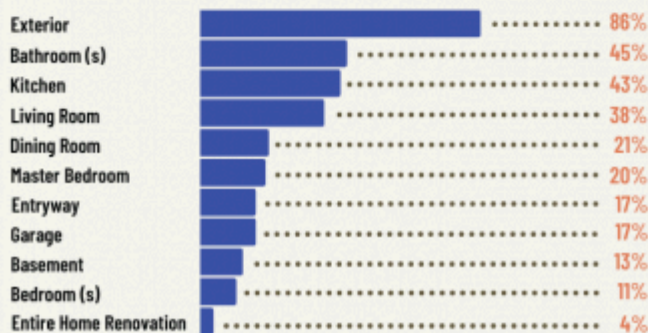
