

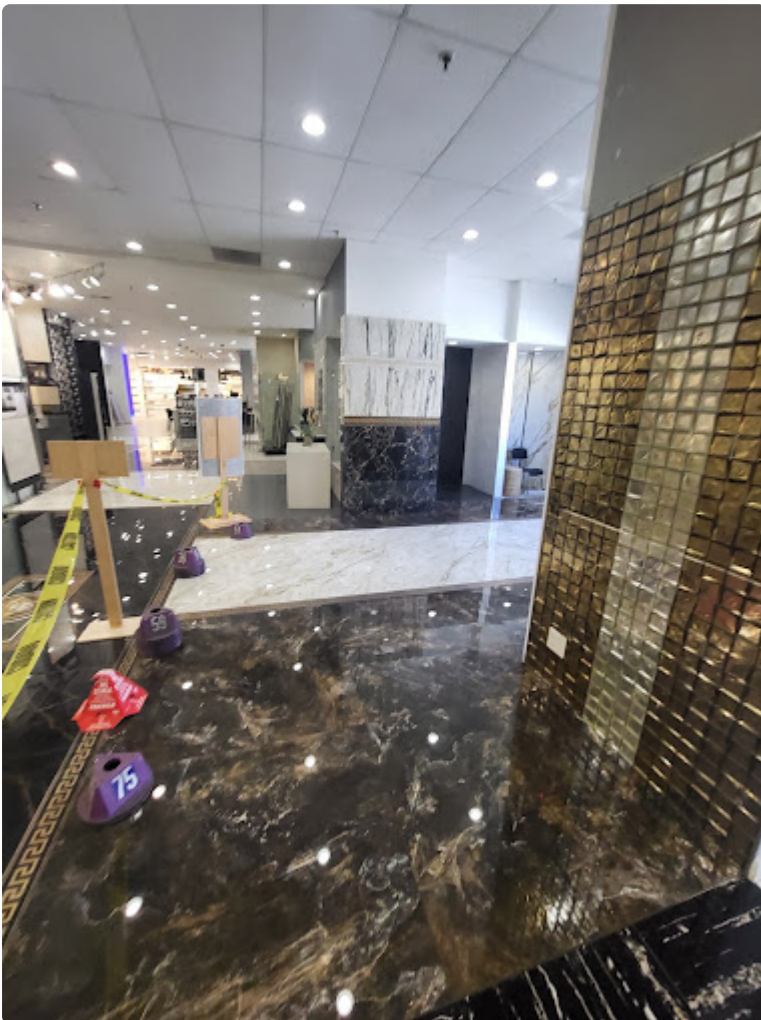

A extreme dwelling baker insisted on honed marble for a twelve-foot island. She accepts patina.
