4. Coinflip

A timeless 1v1 game of opportunity. 2 gamers wager skins of roughly equivalent value. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to choice. Users bet on professional groups utilizing odds determined by the platform, comparable to standard sportsbooks.
