How Does the Diagnostic Fee Workflow Begin When You Call?

That visual scoping is the foundation of the diagnostic fee.

What Does the Initial Inspection Line Item Actually Cover?

How Does Quote Reconciliation Build from the Diagnostic Findings?

Once the inspection is complete, the second workflow phase begins: quote reconciliation. Our technician presents you with a detailed, line-item quote that maps directly to the diagnosis. If a compressor needs replacement, the quote shows the compressor part cost, labor time, and any gaskets or refrigerant required. If a drum bearing has failed, the quote itemizes the bearing, the drum itself if it must come out, and the seal kit. There are no surprises or vague totals. Every line on the quote traces back to a finding from the diagnostic inspection.

This scoping step is critical. Many homeowners don't realize that the average refrigerator repair runs \$200 to \$600, a washing machine \$150 to \$500, and a dryer \$150 to \$400. Those ranges exist because the diagnosis determines the scope. A simple thermostat replacement is far less expensive than a compressor overhaul. By building the quote directly from the diagnostic workflow, you see exactly why your repair costs what it does.

What Role Does Parts-Cost Breakdown Play in the Quote Structure?

What Happens After You Approve the Quote?
