Look for those patterns:

- Chalking and UV burn on south and west faces. If your hand comes away white after a rub, you need a rinse with a slight detergent and, in some instances, an acrylic bonding primer.
- Rust bleed on metallic fasteners and hinges. That wants a rust converter or a right away to steel primer, now not simply extra paint.
- Oil and silicone around storage door tracks and weatherstripping. Solvent cleaning, then a rinse, prevents fish eyes.

On T1-11, I decide on a penetrating alkyd primer on weathered timber, then a complete acrylic topcoat. For new OSB or plywood from a shed package, anticipate mill glaze and prime resin. A scuff sand, a thorough sparkling, and a pleasant bonding primer cease early peeling.

On steel garage doors, the substrate could be manufacturing unit baked tooth or powder coat. Both are slick.
